Domestic and family violence is the main reason for female homelessness.

54,000 women are homeless in Australia every night. More than 1 in 2 women are turned away from crisis accommodation every night.

Over the last 4 years, Parramatta Women's Shelter has:

- Supported 574 clients comprising 211 adults, and 363 children.
- Provided 23,948 bed nights for transitional accommodation.
- Provided 16,771 bed nights for emergency accommodation.

\$60 Provides a bed night to a Domestic Violence client.

Parramatta Women's Shelter (PWS) provides crisis accommodation and outreach support for women and their children experiencing domestic and family violence and/or homelessness. A proud member of the Women's Community Shelters (WCS) network, we work with our local community to inspire, empower and support change for these vulnerable families and for our community. We are highly motivated advocates for change and are driven to deliver best practice service for our families.
